INVITATION TO BID

The Calhoun County Commission will on **Tuesday, August 18, 2026**, at 2:00 p.m. receive competitive sealed bids for Uniforms for the Sheriff's Office and Correction Officers. Specifications are as follows:

- The bid award, if any, will be to the bidder offering the highest percentage off the MSRP of all uniforms in accordance with the bidder's catalog list price.
- Each bidder is required to provide their most current price list at the time of bid.
- All bidders are required to provide a variation of Uniform Trousers to include Class A and Tactical, Shirts to include PDU, Undervest Uniform Shirt and Polo, and light and heavy Jackets, etc.
- Supervisor trousers will have gold stripes sewn on Class A uniform pants by the Successful Bidder and deputy trousers will have colored (TBD) stripe sewn on Class A pants by Successful Bidder.
- Shirts and Jackets will have patches and rank sewn on by Successful Bidder. Patches will be furnished by Sheriff's Office.
- Polo shirts will have an embroidered badge, name and rank sewn on the shirts.

Brand or its equivalent, names may include, but shall not be limited to the following:

The Sheriff will inspect samples, prices, and delivery dates. Samples of uniforms must be supplied prior to bid opening date and will be kept by the Sheriff until uniforms are awarded, at which time it will be the responsibility of each bidder to pick up their samples.

Successful Bidder will send an experienced representative to take orders and measure each employee. The Successful Bidder will be responsible for fitting every employee to his/her satisfaction with no charge for necessary alterations. Any disagreement regarding fit will be decided by the Sheriff.

Uniforms will be delivered complete, no later than three weeks after ordered, to the Sheriff's Office. No partial orders will be accepted. Each employee's order will be bagged individually with his/her name and packing slip attached. Any deviations from the bid specifications must be stated on his/her/its bid sheet. A minimum of 30% of uniforms shall be kept in stock to be purchased as needed.

Sealed bids with the words "Sheriff's Uniform Bid" on the outside must be submitted to the Calhoun County Commission, 1702 Noble Street, Suite 103, Anniston, Alabama 36201, no later than Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. Central Time, at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud. Questions and requests for additional information concerning this solicitation should be directed to Captain Joey Stone, Calhoun County Sheriff's Office, 400 West 8th Street, Anniston, Alabama 36201, (256) 236-6600.

The bid award, if any, will be for one year, effective upon award of bid, with the option to extend annually for two additional one-year terms, if agreeable to the County and the Successful Bidder.

Legal Compliance: The Successful Bidder will, by accepting this bid award, agree to the following: By signing this contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the state of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the contract and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

The Successful Bidder must complete all necessary paperwork required by the County for verification of enrollment in the e-verify program to verify full compliance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, as amended by Immigration Act of 1990 and the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, as amended.

The Successful Bidder will, by accepting this bid award, agree to the following: By signing this Contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of this agreement to remain in compliance with Act 2016-312, the Parties hereby agree that they are not currently engaged in, and will not engage in, the boycott of a person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open trade.

To the fullest extent allowed by law, a preference will be given for American made products.

The Calhoun County Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
