SUMMARY OF MINUTES CALHOUN COUNTY COMMISSION DECEMBER 14, 2017

The regular meeting of the Calhoun County Commission was called to order on this date by Chairman Hudson and all Commissioners were present. County Engineer Brian Rosenbalm gave an invocation.

The Commissioners approved the payment of warrants issued, to-wit:

Commissioner Hess made a motion to adopt the agenda, followed by a second to the motion from Commissioner Patterson. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner Hodges made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the contract for and on behalf of Calhoun County. A motion was made by Commissioner Patterson to authorize the Chairman to sign an agreement, for and on behalf of Calhoun County, with Terracon Consultants, Inc., as presented by Mr. Rosenbalm, providing for construction materials testing services on Brown Bridge Road bridge approaches, located in district 5. Commissioner Hodges made a motion to adopt a resolution naming Branch Bank and Trust (BB&T) of Anniston, Alabama, as the County Depository for Calhoun County, Alabama, for the period January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hess, and the motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Commissioners. (RESOLUTION ATTACHED)

Commissioner Hess made a motion to cancel the regular meeting of the Calhoun County Commission scheduled for Thursday, December 28, 2017. Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion and all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.
